



Pure Flavour Point Series

- Points will accumulate after each event and then we will post total points for each child.
- The top 8 in each age category will be posted after each event during the season with any movement that occurs after each race.

- Results will be posted on both our websites so that the kids can follow how they are doing and any info we may want to post on site.
- Prizes: Each child that completes all 4 events will receive a Fitness Tracker. These trackers will be handed out at our last event Unifor Kids for Hospice on July 29th.
- Event distances — Distances may vary a little at each of our kids triathlons, so please be aware of that.
- Event costs are set by each event organizer.
- Leamington will decide how they award their age group winners, Fitness for Hospice events will award a plaque to the top 3 in each age category M/F.
- Each entry for all our 4 kids' events will also be given a chance to win a \$500 bike with such things as a free Adventure Bay pass, fresh vegetables, water bottle etc.
- We will be awarding to the top 3 boys and girls in the 12-13 age group a free entry into Triathlon Ontario's Youth Series event. This event will be part of our Sunday Tecumseh Triathlon. This will be determined after the Adventure Bay kid's triathlon by picking the top 3 boys and girls in our point's series.
- We will also be setting up a draw for our kid's camp to award 10 free entries. At each of our first three kid's event a parent can sign up their child by filling out a ticket that we will put in our draw barrel with the winners being announced after Adventure Bay kids' event. We will also have a chance for a parent to entry their child's name at The Running Factory's 5 Km Spring Thaw being held at the Running Factory on April 9th.
